- A number of major goals were achieved under my tenure. The *JUA* became increasingly international. The annual acceptance of non-U.S. paper submissions more than tripled. From 2017 to 2020, total article downloads increased by 650% and international downloads by 900%. In 2017, 50% of *JUA* article downloads were in the U.S., while by 2020 only 30% of downloads were in the U.S. The growing influence of the *JUA* was also reflected in the impact factor (IF). In 2019, the *JUA* 2-year IF set a new record (1.619), and then set another record in 2020 (3.377), almost a four-fold increase since I took over the journal in 2015. The 2020 *JUA* CiteScore increased to 3.3. The *JUA* ranked #180/1,269 (85th percentile) in Sociology and Political Science and #32/215 (85th percentile) in Urban Studies.
